

MAPLEBECK PARISH AGM 07 AUG 2020

A socially distanced and remote Parish Meeting was conducted to cover several matters requiring addressing prior to hopefully holding a public meeting in Spring 2021.

Item 1. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN.

It was proposed by Mr D Harrison and seconded by Mr M Hopcroft that Mr B Carson remain in post as Chairman until a full AGM can be convened hopefully in the Spring of 2021. All agreed.

Mr B Carson accepted and stated that he wished to relinquish the position in 2021 and invited anyone interested to stand for election at that proposed AGM.

Item 2. BUDGET

The proposal by the chairman not to set a Parish precept in line with previous years was seconded by Mr R Kinnear and agreed by all.

A zero budget return has been filed with the auditors, a copy displayed in the bus shelter and available on the Maplebeck Website with the accompanying minutes.

The chairman stated that the only ongoing parish bills (The emptying of dog bins) would be covered by private donations up to but not including March 2022.

Item 3. PLANNING

There are two village planning applications which have been circulated:- 20/01198/FUL at Maplebeck Farm to convert a barn to a dwelling and 20/01057/FUL at Mill Barn to construct a timber stable agricultural storage Barn and menage for private use, with a change of part of the site from agriculture to recreational use.

Both have been submitted as approved by the parish with comments on the Mill Barn plan seeking assurances that it would be as stated for private use and not a commercial venture which would cause unacceptable increase traffic affecting adjacent properties to Mill Barn.

Item 4. VILLAGE HALL COMMITTEE (VHC)

The VHC has resigned in full and the following have offered themselves for election:- Charlotte Boyles, Julie Grundy, Rachel Gardner, Bob Gardner, Andrea Sayer and Derek Sayer.

The above were all proposed for election by Mrs J Kinnear and seconded by Mrs S Carson. Everyone was in agreement and the aforementioned duly elected.

A vote of thanks was offered for the great service given to the Committee by Andy Colclough, Sarah Wagstaff and Mark Wagstaff, who are not standing for re-election.

The committee is in urgent need of some new committee members. EVERYONE WELCOME.
